Brick Fund Project 5 Guildford provide emergency shelter and ongoing support to help the homeless into independent living. Donating to a 'Brick Fund' will assist their clients to meet the initial cost of £1000 approx. needed to acquire independent rented accommodation. Carefully assessed clients agree to repay the money gradually to enable others to benefit also. We suggest donations of £1 per brick. See board in the church entrance area.
