**Day for Life** is the day in the Church's year dedicated to raising awareness about the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death. <http://www.dayforlife.org>  
One in four women and about one in six men suffer from domestic abuse in their lifetime. We acknowledge that men, women and children suffer domestic abuse at the hands of husbands, wives, parents and other family members. Violence of this kind should never be tolerated or justified. It is an offence against the dignity of the human person. In particular we wish to highlight the need for public education and action regarding domestic violence, especially against women. Domestic abuse is often a hidden problem, and our aim is for anyone experiencing domestic abuse to feel able to have confidence to seek help within the Church setting.

**At Life Charity**, our hope and commitment remain strong. In May 2019 alone, we have:  
• Supported 285 women and children through our Pregnancy Matters™ housing service  
• Accompanied 355 new clients as they grapple with decisions around a difficult pregnancy  
• Provided practical support to a further 74 families in need. If Life didn't exist, what would happen to these women, children and families?
