The UK Committee on Climate Change report brings us a step closer to the net zero carbon emissions target we need if we're to avoid temperature rises exceeding the 1.5C level, which will spell disaster for the world's poorest communities. Prolife action alerts

Right to Life UK are asking people to contact their MPs after a 22 week-pregnant woman with moderate learning very narrowly escaped an abortion that she didn't want, being imposed on her by the state.

Her baby was healthy and her mother had offered to raise the child. This was supported by the family's social worker, yet the doctors saw fit to attempt to force her into an abortion against her will.

This family ought never to have been put through this ordeal in the first place and therefore Right to Life are seeking to ascertain how many other women may have been forced into unwanted abortions as well as pushing for legislation which would make it clear that the state has no right to force anyone into abortion.
