### **Justice and Peace**

Faith Sharing Groups. This meeting we began with *prayer*, and then viewed a photo of new-born twins and marvelled at the miraculous gift of human life, accompanied by amazement at medical achievement -IVF. Then we soberly contemplated the fate of the remaining embryos - the earliest development of human life - which were (probably) destroyed. In phase 2 of the meeting we reflected on the Sunday Mass readings and consequently our need to dedicate ourselves more to prayer rooted in true humility and total trust in God's power to enable us to lead holy lives. In phase 3 (formation) we recalled the Second Vatican Council's renewed emphasis on the Church (universally and locally) as community - the People of God, and the call to each one of us to be fruitful in our service (*mission*) within the parish community. Finally, all this operates under (and working in collaboration with) the unifying leadership and guidance of the bishops and priests, Church teaching and Tradition. These house meetings are held on Thursdays at 7.30pm, and Fridays at 2pm and are open to all parishioners; please contact the parish office or Mike Harte (01252904103).
