Evangelizing Catholics 'Book Club'

We are encouraging everyone to read Scott Hahn's 'Evangelizing Catholics' as a good way of engaging with the call for each one of us to engage with the new evangelization.

'All evangelizers proclaim who Christ is. Catholic evangelizers proclaim a Eucharistic Christ....The endgame is heaven and the way to get there is through the Eucharist. It's through our full participation in the Body of Christ, receiving God's own life through the Sacraments.'
