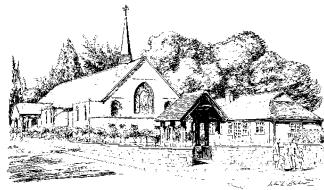
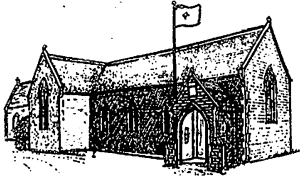

Celebrating the Risen Jesus As we continue to celebrate the Easter season we are asked to continue to draw close to the risen Jesus. A few resources that may help you do this: Over Easter, David Suchet read the whole of the St John's gospel from Westminster Abbey over and it is very worth watching on youtube. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PKiAXVxOm6o> It's an excellent reading - it really feels like he is in your living room reading the Gospel to you, and its very powerful hearing the whole Gospel rather than the snippets we often do. He also gives a lovely ten minute interview which might well encourage you to listen to the Gospel reading. There is also a tv drama of the life of Christ being made at the moment, called The Chosen. It is being made free via an app and youtube, though of course you can contribute to the project if you find it helpful.
