


### **Qu. 7 Why did God have to show himself in order for us to be able to know what he is like?**

Man can know by reason that God exists, but not what God is really like. Yet because God would very much like to be known, he has revealed himself. God did not have to reveal himself to us. But he did it—out of love. Just as in human love one can know something about the beloved person only if he opens his heart to us, so too we know something about God's inmost thoughts only because the eternal and mysterious God has opened himself to us out of love. From creation on, through the patriarchs and the prophets down to the definitive revelation in his Son Jesus Christ, God has spoken again and again to mankind. In him he has poured out his heart to us and made his inmost being visible for us.

**Amazing Victory for Right to Life!** MPs have decided not to take amendments NC 55 and 42 to the vote. These would have introduced abortion on demand, for any reason, up to birth; and a jail sentence of up to 2 years for offering support to women outside abortion clinics nationwide.

Right to Life UK would like to thank all the thousands of people that rallied over the weekend to get friends and family to email their MPs. MPs received more emails ahead of this vote than they have ever received ahead of an abortion vote, and in some cases, MPs received more emails on this issue than they had received on any other issue while in office. Thank you also to our supporters who have given so generously to enable us to have the resources in place to run a very large campaign against these amendments.
