


**We are experimenting with reintroducing the offertory collection in the mass.** For many of us the DONA machine will continue to be the preferable way to give (in which case let the basket pass you by!), but this enables us to acknowledge the collection as we symbolically lay it before the altar and for those who still use cash will make it easier to differentiate between main offertory collection and the second collections when we have them.

Call for Prayer and Fasting for Peace in the Holy Land

As we look on at the humanitarian catastrophe in the Holy Land with hearts that cry out to God for an end to war and violence, the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem, His Beatitude Pierbattista Pizzaballa, has called for Tuesday 17 October to be a day of fasting, abstinence, and prayer for peace and reconciliation. Bp Richard suggests it would be wonderful if we could offer a rosary each day for the intentions of peace in the world. "I know from personal experience the appreciation of the Christian community in the Holy Land who find comfort in knowing they are remembered in prayer. Our prayers have their effect in ways we do not see and in places to which we have never travelled."

O God of peace, who are peace itself  
and whom a spirit of discord cannot grasp,  
nor a violent mind receive,  
grant that those who are one in heart  
may persevere in what is good  
and that those in conflict  
may forget evil and so be healed.
