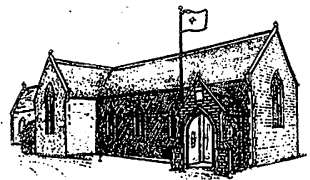
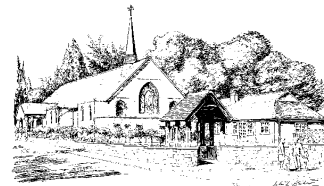

We will be praying the rosary before mass at Holy Angels again celebrating the different cultures present in our parish with different languages.

Also can we have three volunteers to help with teas and coffees after the the remembrance service parade in the Ash Centre. (11am).
