Message from the Holy Angels Parish Finance Committee

The front car park should be resurfaced and that access to the car park should be controlled by gates. At this stage we expect the resurfacing work to be carried out during August This has become necessary because the volume of use of the car park, especially by non parishioners, has led to its become very worn in places, creating a potential health and safety hazard. Access to the car park is now controlled by gates to prevent a similar deterioration in the future.

Since the car park is for the use of the church and its parishioners, the gates will normally remain closed except for church events. The PFC is aiming to ensure that this causes no inconvenience to parishioners but it will obviously be helpful if access is required outside the normal requirements of Masses etc if Fr Robin is informed in advance.

We are keeping one of the gates open while the parish office is open of Wednesday and Friday mornings, and there is enough space to pull up in front of the gates opposite the rear car park entrance if you are dropping something off for Fr Robin

If anyone who normally does volunteering tasks at the church such as cleaning and is therefore affected by the introduction of the gates has not yet been contacted by the parish office please email Gloria and we will make sure you have access!
