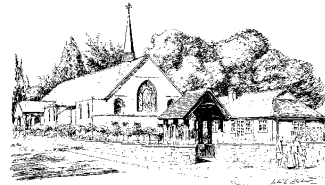

STOP ASSISTED SUICIDE

The Second Reading of the Bill takes place this Friday 29th November.

1. If you have not already done so all Catholics are asked to write to their MP asking them to vote against this measure. 2. As an additional measure you could sign a Petition addressed as an open Petition to all MP's. Poster with a QR code at the back of Church.
3. On the morning of 29th November Bp Richard asks all of us again to joint together in prayer for our MP's to vote against this measure, for all the vulnerable people who would be affected by this, and for s restoration of a culture of life in our countries.
4. We are encouraged to Fast if we are able to.
5. At Holy Angels the church will be open from 10am for an hour for people to come and pray with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament as Bp Richard has encouraged us to.
6. Some may want to gather in Parliament Square 8.30am to 2.30pm. Placards and T-Shirts provided. Nearest tube: Westminster & St James Park.

**Missio Red Boxes at Holy
Angels**

30th November/1st December to

Following their Autumn Plenary
in Leeds last week, the Bishops
of England and Wales joined the
Bishops of Scotland in issuing a
joint statement on the proposed
legislation. Addressing people
across the UK they said:
"Assisted suicide raises serious
issues of principle.

The time given for Parliament to
consider the Bill... is woefully
inadequate... In Belgium, the
Netherlands, Canada, and parts
of the USA, the criteria for
assisted suicide have been
expanded significantly, in law or
in practice, often to include
people with mental illness and
others who have no terminal
diagnosis.

"We are alarmed by the impact
that legalisation will have on the
most vulnerable members of our
society. The option to end life
can quickly, and subtly, be
experienced as a duty to die.
Some may well feel their
continued existence is a burden
to others, and, implicitly or
explicitly, be pressured into
assisted suicide. This includes
people who are elderly, infirm,
and living with disabilities. The
protection of such people is the
foundation of civilised society. It
is at the heart of good
government."

Holy Angels is 90Years Old!

Not quite a Centenary, but Holy
Angels Church was opened on 2nd
December 2034. To celebrate this
we are asking people to consider

Step by Step Charity which
supports homeless young people.

As Christians we are particularly
sensitive at Christmas to those not
able to be in their own home at
Christmas – especially as we
celebrate our own beautiful
Christian home.
