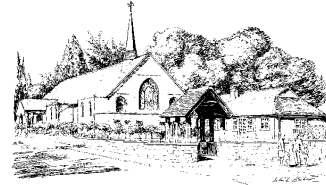

Baptism Preparation Morning Saturday 18th January 10.30 am till Noon. It's a great joy when your parish can help you to share your faith with your children. In order to begin the process of preparing for baptism you are expected to be already attending church with your child on a weekly basis for at least 2 months. In choosing to baptize your child you are promising to bring them up as a Catholic, which of course includes bringing them to mass with you. Application forms are then available for you to fill in at the back of church – which need to be signed by Fr Robin – and then given in to the parish office so we can invite you to a baptism preparation morning.
