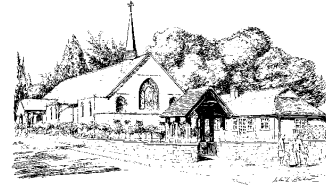

Concelebrated Parish Masses

The clergy of the deanery – who will become the clergy team serving the new parish structure – meet on the 2nd Tuesday of the month as a team. Going forward these meeting will usually begin with a concelebrated mass.

“Concelebration provides a witness to and a service of communion not only for the community directly taking part in the celebration but also for the universal Church, which is always brought into play within the context of the Eucharist.” It is an important expression of their shared responsibility for the body of Christ in the area and they hope that many of the faithful may wish to join them in the celebration of the Eucharist on these days.

This will affect our existing Tuesday mass at Holy Family. Either this means that once a month there will be no Tuesday morning mass in the parish or we could consider our Holy Family mass schedule. Those who attend weekday mass at Holy Family are invited to talk to Fr Robin about this.
