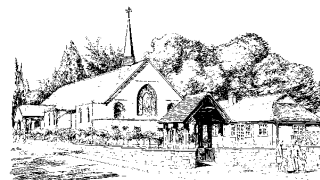

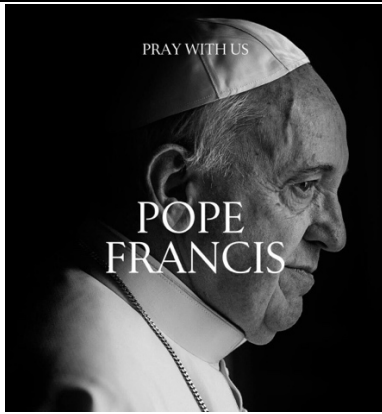

### **ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL**

**On 16 May MPs will again vote on the Terminally Ill Adults(End of Life) Bill.**

**Pleas weroite again to your MP**

Please ask your MP:

What can be done to ensure well-resourced and co-ordinated end of life care at home or close to home

How concerns about coercion and undue influence as well as domestic abuse and violence are to be tackled

What thought has been given to the unintended consequences of making lethal doses of unregulated drugs available within the NHS for doctors to assist patients in ending their own lives

How many incorrect deaths are acceptable? A Private Members' Bill is not the right vehicle to overturn the Hippocratic Oath.

What does this bill mean for the future of our society and our values?

**(RCIA) 2025/26:** Adults who may be considering baptism, and adults baptised in another Christian tradition who are now considering coming into full communion with the Catholic Church, Lent and Easter is the time to reflect deeply on whether it is time for them to join the next RCIA programme, with a view to possible Baptism or Reception at **Easter 2026.
