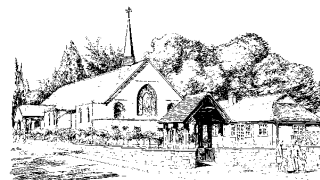

The Word became poor and dwelt among us

A journey through the advent season with the scriptures and Pope Leo's new letter on love for the poor.

For Christians, the poor are not a sociological category, but the very "flesh" of Christ. It is not enough to profess the doctrine of God's Incarnation in general terms. To enter truly into this great mystery, we need to understand clearly that the Lord took on a flesh that hungers and thirsts, and experiences in firmity and imprisonment.

This Advent, as we reflect in our Diocese on deepening our call to prayer, formation and mission you are invited to join us in praying with

some of the Sunday readings and reflecting on Pope Leo's first main teaching document on Love for the Poor (known by its Latin title Dilexi Te).

Month of the Holy Souls

November is dedicated to praying for the Souls of the departed, with a special emphasis on the souls in purgatory.

We have a book of the dead in which you are invited to write the names of your departed loves. This book is placed on the altar at each mass and your loved ones remembered as a special intention.

We are also encouraged to offer individual masses during this month especially – please contact the office in the normal way for this.

Following Bishop Richard's recent pastoral letter it has now been confirmed that **Guildford Deanery will become the new Parish of Guildford at the start of Advent.** Our church communities will continue to be the places in which the Gospel is proclaimed and the sacraments celebrated, and to be led by priests assigned to them, as at present. Working together will help us to be more effective in our prayer, formation and mission. Fr Robin, together with Fr Simon will look after Farnham, Ash & Heath End, which will together form a 'hub' as part of the larger Parish.

Bishop Richard will celebrate Mass at 6pm on Saturday 29th November at St Joseph's Guildford at which the new parish will be entrusted to its team of priests and Fr Jonathan will take possession as their moderator. As many as are able from across the deanery, especially our parish, are warmly encouraged to attend.

There will be no other Vigil masses celebrated at Holy Angels or across the new parish as all the clergy will be there with Bp Richard.
